The attention of the Officers noted in the address entry is invited to the subject matter and they are informed that the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in its orders dated 22-01-2015 in W.P.No. 17377 of 2014 filed by Dr. Dr. J. Sowjanya Kumari, Associate Professor of OBG, SVMC, Tirupati, has ordered that the petitioner deserves to be continued as Associate Professor of OBG in the panel year 2003-2004 for the date of her original promotion as Associate Professor of OBG i.e., w.e.f. 28-10-2003, and her case for promotion to the category of Professor of OBG has to be examined with reference to that date subject to her eligibility in terms of the Rules.

In this connection they are requested to display the circular in the Notice Board of the institution concerned with a request to call for the objections, if any from the faculty of OBG in the cadre of Associate Professors and Professors regarding placing her name in the panel 2003-2004 in the cadre of Associate Professor of OBG in light of High Court orders, so as to take further necessary action as desired by the Govt. in Govt.
