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The Medical Superintendent, Govt. Area Hospital, Bodhan is informed that, the Government in the reference cited has issued the G.O. Ms No: 304 HM & FW (K2) Dept, dated: 27.10.2010, for shifting of School of Nursing District Head Quarters Hospital, Nizamabad to School of Nursing Area Hospital Bodhan with an intake capacity of 25 students per academic year 2010-2011 and start the classes immediately i.e from the academic year 2010-2011 and also requested the Director of Medical Education shall take necessary action to approach Nursing Council of India for obtaining needed approvals for the Nursing School, Bodhan and also take necessary steps to utilize the available vacant infrastructural facilities in the Area Hospital, Bodhan and also the vacant RMO Quarter there which are considered to be adequate as per norms of the INC to start the first year classes immediately.

Hence, the following selection committee is constituted for finalizing the selection process of 1<sup>st</sup> year GNM students at School of Nursing, Government Area Hospital, Bodhan and the selection committee has to complete the selection process by **10.11.2010** and commence the classes from **16.11.2010**.

- 1) The superintendent of M.G.M. Hospital, Warangal – Chairman
- 2) The Superintendent, Govt. Area Hospital, Bodhan
- 3) In – Charge Principal, School of Nursing, Govt. Area Hospital, Bodhan.

Further, The Medical Superintendent, Area Hospital, Bodhan is requested to issue an advertisement of following Notification in main edition of the two local popular daily newspapers, one of which be in Telugu inviting applications seeking admissions into 1<sup>st</sup> year of 3 (Three) year General Nursing & Midwifery Training Course and (6) Six months internship from the candidates (Male & Female) for the Academic year 2010-2011.

**EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

Candidates should have passed XII class OR Intermediate or its equivalent examination preferable with Science subjects. As per the G.O Ms No: 410 HM &FW (K2) Dept, Dated: 28.11.2008. MPHWH (F) candidates who have passed ANM course of 18 months are eligible to admit into GNM course and they are exempted 6 months duration in GNM course subject to the condition that they shall under go the revised training programme as laid by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

The aggregate marks of minimum 45% in Intermediate or its equivalent examination fixed by the Indian Nursing Council for admissions into Nursing Schools (for admissions into General Nursing and Midwifery Course) are relaxed in favour of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates and they shall be eligible if they passed, Intermediate or its equivalent examination;

In respect of admission of general category candidates for the said course, i.e., for O.C. candidates, the condition of minimum 45% aggregate marks in intermediate or its equivalent examination should be followed as per the Indian Nursing Council regulations. After first phase of Notification, counseling and wide publicity, if vacancies of General Category seats are unfilled and the candidates of OC category are not available with 45% aggregate marks in Intermediate or in its equivalent examination, then only the unfilled vacancies in the General Category shall be filled up with OC candidates with a pass in Intermediate or its equivalent examination. The existing Rule of Reservation as being implemented now shall be followed;

**AGE:-**

The minimum age shall be 16 years completed and enter 17<sup>th</sup> year as on the 1<sup>st</sup> July of the year and shall not have completed 35 years of age. The upper age limit for the candidates belonging to SC, ST and BC's relaxable by 3 years.

The Department will not be held responsible for any postal delays for non-receipt of applications on or before the stipulated date i.e. **08.11.2010** by 5.00 p.m.

Note:- 1:- Selections will be made purely on merit, on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the Candidates in the group subjects, excluding languages. In deciding merit candidates who qualify under compartmental system will be placed after candidates who passed in a single attempt

Note:- 2:- Incomplete applications or applications submitted without attested copies of Relevant documents will not be entertained.

Note:- 3:- The SC/ST/BC candidates should furnish the prescribed Caste Certificate Given at (Annexure I) signed by the competent authority not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer.

Note:- 4:- 85% of seats in local area are reserved in favour of local candidates in relation to the local area and the remaining seats are un-reserved as per A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of admissions order 1974 as issued in G.O.P No. 646 Edn. (W) Dept., Dated 10-07-1979).

Note:- 5:- Out of the seats available for admission 15% SC, 6% for ST and 25% for BCs are reserved.

Note:- 6:- Migration Certificate of the students admitted from other than Andhra Pradesh State should be produced otherwise will be cancelled by the selection committee.

Hence, the Medical Superintendent, Govt. Area Hospital, Bodhan is requested to collect the GNM Admission application forms from this office immediately duly deputing responsible official and take immediate action in this regard and submit compliance report.
