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It is to stated that the General Nursing and Midwifery marks memos are being issued to the Nursing Schools through Mee Seva service centers from Nov 2014 onwards. From the beginning there are so many technical problems aroused in issuing marks like name errors, pass instead of fail, jumbling of marks, half sheet printing and many more problems. This office has made number of attempts to bring their notice regarding rectification of the problems. Every time, concerned case workers are transferred thus whenever new person come to that place, the issue become new to them. Nobody is taking care about rectification of the errors in the marks memos. There are about 20,000 marks memos being issued to students every year. Out of them 70% of the marks memos going wrong printing. Students are facing very much trouble with the marks memos which are being issued through Mee Seva.

Recently, thousands of marks memos are printed wrong and some marks memos are not displayed. All these problems were brought to the notice of the concerned but our attempts are become futile. Now they stopped issuing of marks memos in all Districts. It is very difficult to the pass out students to get jobs without marks memos. Now it is high time to take a decision on the matter whether their services are to be continued or not.

In view of the above situation, it is proposed that till the technical corrections are made in their office, this office may issue consolidated marks memos for the students who didn't get marks memos from Meeseva for third year out going students as an alternative temporary arrangement on producing necessary proofs (Acknowledgments) so as to protect the interest of the students.

This has got the approval of the Director of Medical Education, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada.
