- 1. Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for the post of Assistant Professors in the Government medical colleges and Teaching Hospitals under Directorate of Medical Education.
- 2. Recruitment is through regular basis and contract basis.

- 5. Local candidates are eligible for apply to the regular recruitment. Non-Local Candidates can also apply; however, they will be considered for the contract basis subject to availability of vacancy and non-availability of Local candidates. Further, if local candidates are not fitting into roster points, they will be eligible for contract basis recruitment.
- 6. Interested candidates are requested to attend the walk-in-recruitment with the following original certificates and one set of xerox copies:
  - a. SSC Certificates (proof of date of birth)
  - b. Intermediate certificate
  - c. MBBS Degree Certificate
  - d. PG Degree Certificate/Super-Specialty degree certificate
  - e. PG degree marks memo/Super-Specialty degree marks memo: Marks list in concerned subjects (All marks memo)
  - f. AP Medical Council Registration Certificate
  - g. Senior Residency (SR) Completion certificate (Not required for super specialities)
  - h. Caste certificate in case of SC/ST/BC or Social Status (Including EWS) Certificate issued by Competent authority.
  - i. Study Certificate from 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Class. In case of study of 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in Telangana and migrated to AP after bifurcation, then certificate from the revenue authorities to that effect as per G.O.Ms.No.132 & 133 GA (SPF&MC) Dept. 13.06.2016 (proof of local candidate)
  - j. Disability Certificate if applicable issued by concerned medical board or SADAREM.
  - k. If person belongs to Ex-service man, certificate on the same.
  - 1. Contract service certificate from DMHO/DCHS/Medical Superintendent/Principal (for the period after completion of PG degree), Contract service will not be given without proper service certificate from the DMHO/DCHS/Medical Superintendent/Principal.
  - m. In case of doctors who are presently employed with state or central Government, NOC from the appointing authority.
- 7. Candidates shall attend the Directorate of Medical Education during the schedule day and submit their application in the formats provided by the DME office. No application will be considered other than submitted by the candidate on the day of schedule.
- 8. Details of speciality wise vacancies & roster points will be notified before the scheduled walk-in recruitment.

#### **3.** Age:

- a. OC candidate should not have completed 42 years as on 12-10-2022 (should not have been born before 11-10-1980)
- b. EWS/SC/ST/BC candidates should not have completed 47 years as on 12-10-2022 (should not have been born before 11-10-1975)
- c. Physically Handicapped persons should not have completed 52 years as on 12-10-2022 (should not have been born before 11-10-1970)
- d. Ex-service men should not have completed 50 years as on 04-08-2022 (should not have born before 11-10-1972)
- 4. Rule of Reservations will apply as per A.P. State Govt. Rules in force.

#### 5. Local candidature:

- a. Candidates who belong to Andhra Pradesh (AP) only need to apply. (Local candidates who studied from 4<sup>th</sup> Class to 10<sup>th</sup> Class in the State of A.P. and candidates who migrated to any part of AP from the State of Telangana within a period of 3 years from 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2014. (As per G.O. No. 132 GAD Dt.13-6-2016 & G.O.Ms.No. 133 GAD 13.06.2016).
- b. The Residence Certificate / Nativity Certificate issued by MRO/Tahasildar will not be allowed for Local consideration without mentioning the G.O. No. 132 GAD Dt.13-6-2016 & G.O.Ms.No. 133 GAD 13.06.2016 for the candidate who studied in the state of Telangana before bifurcation.
- c. The Residence Certificate will not be accepted if a Candidate has studied in any Educational Institutions up to SSC or equivalent Examination, such candidates have to produce study certificates invariably.

### 6. Pay Scale:

a. Salary will be paid as per the rules in force till the completion of probation period. The 7<sup>th</sup> UGC Pay scales (G.O.Ms.No. 22, HM & FW (A1) Dept., Dated 01.03.2021) will be applicable after completion of the probation period.

#### 7. Selection Procedure:

- a. Merit list will be prepared for all the candidates who attended walk-inrecruitment and submitted the applications. Merit list will be prepared based on the following marks matrix:
- b. Total Marks 100

- i. 75 Marks based on the marks / grade obtained in the qualifying degree. Those who are not having PG marks memo or grade, percentage of marks to be taken as 50% (50% x 75=37.50)
  - a. It is the responsibility of the candidate to obtain and submit marks memos from the competent authorities where ever grades instead of marks are issued.
  - b. Weightage for Number of years since passing qualifying examination is up to 10 marks @ 1 mark per PG / Super-specialty completed year.
  - c. Regarding the Grades: (Marks will be considered as 75%) (As per Govt Memo No. 4296/A1/2015, Dated 22.04.2015)
  - Grade A Distinction 75% to 85% mean 80%
     Grade B+ Above Average 65% to 74% mean 70%
     Grade B Pass 50% to 64% mean 57%
- ii. 15 (Fifteen) Marks to the contract service rendered in Government institutions
  - a. Weightage for Contract service in Govt. Institutions up to 15 marks. Contract service can be calculated from the date of completion of Post-Graduation (requisite qualification) only.
    - a) 2.5. marks per six months in Tribal Area.
    - b) 2 marks per six months in Rural Area.
    - c) 1 mark per six months in Urban Area
  - b. Weightage will be awarded up to 15% for the candidates who rendered their services on contract basis for COVID -19 duties. They should submit the Service Certificate issued by the competent authority and signed by the Superintendent of Teaching Hospital/DM & HO / DCHS should be enclosed. This weightage will be awarded as per G.O.Rt. No. 211, HM & FW (B2) Dept., Dated 08.05.2021 and G.O.Rt.No.7 HM&FW(B2) Department Dt.06.01.2022 read with circular no. 03/CHFW/2022, dated 11.02.2022 of CHFW AP.
    - i. Following documents to be submitted to claim COVID-19 weightage:
      - 1. Appointment order for COVID-19 management
      - 2. Monthly attendance certificates
      - 3. Bank statement indicating payment of monthly remuneration along with COVID-19 weightage service certificate
  - c. 5 (five) marks of weightage will be provided to the candidates in the recruitment of Assistant Professors, who have completed PG/Super Specialty from Central Institutions. However, total weightage is maximum of 15 marks only.
  - d. Note:
    - i. Contract service will be reckoned up to the date of notification i.e., 12<sup>th</sup> October 2022 as per Govt. Memo no.4274/D1/2013, HM&FW (D1) Dept., dt.10.07.2014.

ii. Spells of services will also be considered for weightage marks.

## iii. <u>In-service candidate</u>:

- a. Candidate who is already in service and desires to apply in Direct Recruitment shall have to obtain NOC from concerned Director/Commissioner/DME and enclose the same.
- b. Such candidates, if already claimed benefit of weightage in the earlier recruitment will not be getting the benefit for second time.
- c. Such candidates, if selected, will have to submit accepted resignation letter from the concerned Director/Commissioner/DME and then only will be permitted to join as Assistant Professor.
- 8. The decision of the selection committee as per G.O. Ms. No. 109, HM & FW (A2) Dept., Dt. 23.6.2014, Govt., Memo No.4298/A1/2015 HM&FW (A2) Dept dated 22-04-2015 and G.O. Ms. No. 154, HM & FW (A1) Dept., Dt. 4.5.2002 in all aspects and all respects pertaining to application and its acceptance or rejection as the case may be, the selection or otherwise of any candidate shall be final in all respects and binding on all concerned.
- 9. The recruitment is subject to the outcome of any O.As/W.Ps pending before court and likely to arise in the matter.
- 10. The selection committee also reserves its rights to alter or modify regarding conditions laid down in the notification for final selection and also posts notified.
