The Department of Health, Medical and Family Welfare, Government of Andhra Pradesh invites applications from eligible individuals/organizations for nomination as non-official members of the State Mental Health Authority to be constituted under Section 46 of the Mental Health Care Act 2017 & The Mental Health Care (State Mental Health Authority) Rules, 2018.

1.	Eminent Psychiatrist -1, as defined in clause (y) of sub-section (1) of Section (2) of the Mental Health Care Act 2017 .
2.	Mental Health Professional -1, as defined in item (iii) of clause (r) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Mental Health Care Act 2017 having at least fifteen years of experience in the field.
3.	Clinical Psychologist -1, having at least fifteen years of experience.
4.	Psychiatric Social Worker:-1, having at least fifteen years of experience
5.	Mental Health Nurse-1, having at least fifteen years of experience in the field of Mental health.
6.	Persons representing persons who have or have had mental illness-2
7.	Persons representing care-givers of persons with mental illness or organizations representing care-givers -2
8.	Persons representing non-governmental organizations which provide services to persons with mental illness -2

Eligibility Conditions:


1. The applicant shall be an Indian National
2. The applicants shall not be of the age exceeding 67 years.
3. Persons applying for categories under clauses (g)(h)(i)(j)(k)(l)(m) and (n) of sub-section (1) of section 46 under State Mental Health Authority Rules 2018 shall be registered with the State Mental Health Authority, such person is working an undertaking to the effect that registration will be got done after constitution of the State Mental Health Authority.

The eligibility criteria, the term of office, allowances etc of non-official members of State Mental Health Authority will be as per the provisions of the Mental Health Care Act 2017 and Rules frames which are available on the website of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (www.mohfw.nic.in).

Applications along with required certificates/documents shall be submitted through ordinary post/speed post /by hand to the **Chief Executive Officer**, State Mental Health Authority, O/o. Director of Medical Education A.P Old Govt. General Hospital Campus, Hanumanpet, Vijayawada on or before 31st August 2018.
