

GOVERNMENT OF ANDHRA PRADESH DIRECTORATE OF MEDICAL EDUCATION OLD GOVT. GENERAL HOSPITAL CAMPUS, VIJAYAWADA. NOTIFICATION FOR ALLOTMENT OF POSTINGS FOR PG STUDENTS UNDER COMPULSORY GOVERNMENT SERVICE IN DME & DSH HOSPITALS Dated:26-12-2025.

- 1. Applications are invited online from the PG students who are under the purview of compulsory Rural/Government service and joined in state Quota in Government Medical Colleges and 'Category A' seats in Private Medical Colleges as per the G.O. Ms. No. 251, HM & FW (C1) Department dated 02.10.2025 and G.O. Ms. No. 267, HM & FW (C1) Department dated 20.10.2025 to render one year service in DSH and DME hospitals.
- 2. Remuneration/Honorarium: Vide G.O.Ms. No. 723, HM&FW (C1) Department, Dt: 04.12.2024 Rs 80,500/- PM will be drawn by the Principals of Government Medical Colleges, designating them as Senior Residents.
- 3. The duration of compulsory service is One (1) year only.

4. Application Procedure:

- **a.** Applicants are instructed to submit the application online through the link sent to the mobile number already linked to the hall ticket by entering the **OTP**.
- **b.** Candidate should exercise the option in the seventeen (17) medical colleges and also DH/AH/CHC for peripheral postings of 6 months.
- c. Applications shall be submitted online from 12 Noon of 27/12/2025 to 05:00 pm of 29/12/2025.
- **d.** No application will be accepted in off line mode.

5. Selection Process:

- **a.** The merit scored in post-graduation exam (theory) will be the criteria for preparing merit list.
- **b.** In case of more than one candidate having the same marks, Date of Birth will be taken into consideration and elder person will be given first preference.

Note: All candidates who joined in PG course in state quota in Govt. Medical colleges and Category – A seats in private medical colleges must exercise **one-time options for all colleges and hospitals**. Candidates who have not exercised options will be issued postings in remaining places by default.
