NOTIFICATION FOR THE POSTS OF SENIOR RESIDENTS-2026
NOTIFICATION No.2/2026, Dated: 10-07-2026**

1. Applications are invited online from the eligible Post Graduates for the posts of Senior Residents in Broad and Super Specialties in Government Medical Colleges and Hospitals under the Directorate of Medical Education, A.P list of the Medical Colleges are annexed.
2. Total Number of vacancies are **234**.
3. The number of Vacancies are provisional and likely to increase and decrease.
4. **ELIGIBILITY:**
 - a. Eligibility shall be as per the National Medical Commission regulations
 - b. Postgraduate degree MD/MS/ in the concerned Speciality
Or
DNB in Broad Specialties granted by a Medical Institution with a attached Hospital or in a Hospital with a strength of 500 or more beds granted by National Board of Examination are only eligible as per Teachers Eligibility Qualifications in Medical Institutions Regulations, 2022
 - c. Registered in the AP Medical Council
 - d. Must not cross the age of 44 years as on date of notification (**50 years** in pre-clinical and para-clinical subjects such as Anatomy, Physiology, Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology and Forensic Medicine).
5. Local Candidates to AP state are eligible for selection. Non-Local candidates with AP Medical Registration are eligible for Senior Residency if local candidates are not available
(NOTE: Local Candidature: -A candidate studied at least 4 years from 4th to 10th in AP. In case of study of 4th to 10th in Telangana and migrated to AP after bifurcation, then certificate from the revenue authorities to that effect as per G.O.Ms.No.132 & 133 GA (SPF&MC) Dept. 13.06.2016 (proof of local candidate)**)**
6. Remuneration/Honorarium: Vide G.O.Ms. No. 723 HM&FW (C1) Department, Dt: 04.12.2024 - Rs 80,500/- PM for Broad Specialties, .
7. Tenure:
 - a. The post of Senior Residents are tenured positions for 1 year only.
 - b. Selected candidates are to compulsorily complete one year period.

8. Application Procedure:

- a. Applicants are instructed to submit the application online with the following documents:

1	S.S.C. certificate (Proof of date of birth)
2	Registration of PG degree with A.P. Medical Council.
3	Marks lists of Post-graduation (MD/MS/DNB). Applications without mark list will not be considered.
4	Copy of Degree/Provisional Degree Certificates of 1. MBBS 2. Post-graduation MD/MS/DNB
5	Study Certificate from 4 th to 10 th Class. Incase of study of 4 th to 10 th in Telangana and migrated to AP after bifurcation, then certificate from the revenue authorities to that effect as per G.O.Ms.No.132 & 133 GA (SPF&MC) Dept. 13.06.2016 (proof of local candidate)
6	Social Status Certificate (SC /ST /BCA /BCB/ BCC /BCD /BCE /EWS)
7	PH certificate
8	Aadhar Card

- b. Applications shall be submitted online between 15/07/2026 to 19/07/2026.
- c. No application will be received off line
- d. Senior Residents already working in the Government Medical Colleges of AP are not eligible and the application will not be considered.
- e. Application submitted without certificates mentioned at 8 a (1) to 8 a (5) will be rejected
9. Fee of Rs 2000/- for OCs and Rs 1000/- for BC,SC and ST shall be paid online while submitting the application
10. Selection Process:
- a. The merit scored in post-graduation exam (including theory & practical) will be the criteria for preparing merit list & further giving postings as Senior Residents duly following rule of reservation (RoR).
- b. Rule of Reservation as per State and Subordinate Services will be followed.
- c. In case of more than one candidate is having the same marks, Date of Birth will be taken into consideration and elder person will be given first preference.
- d. The selection committee also reserves its rights to alter or modify regarding conditions laid down in the notification for final selection and also posts notified.
