## I. VACANCIES AND EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for the post of Specialist Doctors and General Duty Medical Officer in Super Speciality Hospital with Kidney Research Centre and Dialysis Unit at Palasa in Srikakulam District

# 2. Recruitment is on a contract basis for the period of Two years

**6.** Pay:

- a. Rs 1,60,000/- for super specialties
- b. Rs 1,10,000/- for broad specialities
- c. Rs 85,000/- for General Duty Medical Officers
- 7. Candidates shall stay at the Head Quarters

### <u>7 AGE</u>:

- i. OC candidate should not have completed 42 years as on date of Notification
- ii. EWS/SC/ST/BC candidates should not have completed 47 years as on date of Notification
- iii. Physically Handicapped persons should not have completed 52 years as on date of Notification
- iv. Ex-servicemen should not have completed 50 years as on date of Notification
- 1. Rule of Reservation will apply as per A.P State and Subordinate service Rules in force and also as per GO Ms No 857 HM&FW Department Dt 14.11.2022 and GO Ms No 858 HM&FW Department Dt 14.11.2022.
- **2.** ONLY LOCAL candidates are ELIGIBLE to apply for direct recruitment. NON-LOCAL candidates are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply.

#### 3. LOCAL CANDIDATURE:

- Candidates who are Local to Andhra Pradesh ONLY need to apply. (Candidates who studied from 4<sup>th</sup> Class to 10<sup>th</sup> Class in the State of A.P. and candidates who migrated to any part of AP from the State of Telangana within a period of 3 years from 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2014. (As per G.O. 132 GAD Dt. 13-6-2016 & G.O.Ms.No. 133 GAD Dt. 13.06.2016) are considered as Local).
- ii. The Residence Certificate/ Nativity/ Domicile Certificate issued by MRO/ Tahasildar will not be allowed for Local consideration without mentioning the G.O. No. 132 GAD Dt.13-6-2016 & G.O.Ms.No.133GAD Dt. 13.06.2016 for the candidate who studied in the state of Telangana before bifurcation.
- iii. The Residence Certificate will not be accepted if a Candidate has studied in any Educational Institutions up to SSC or equivalent Examination, such candidates have to produce study certificates invariably.

#### 8 SELECTION PROCEDURE :

- A. Selection will be based on merit and rule of reservation
- B. Merit list will be prepared for all the candidates who applied online and fulfilled all the eligibility conditions. Selection lists will be prepared based on merit lists and roster points as per the Rules of Reservation issued in AP State and Subordinate Services.
- C. Total Marks -100
- D. 75 Marks based on the marks / grade obtained in the qualifying degree. <u>Those who are not having PG marks memo or Grade, percentage of</u> <u>marks will be taken as 50% (50% x 75=37.50)</u>
  - a. It is the responsibility of the candidate to obtain and submit marks memos from the competent authorities where ever grades instead of marks are issued.\_

<u>Regarding the Grades</u>: (Marks will be considered as75%) (As per Govt Memo No. 4296/A1/2015, Dated 22.04.2015)

1) Grade – A	Distinction	75% to 85% mean 80%
2) Grade – B+	Above Average	65% to 74% mean 70%
3) Grade – B	Pass	50% to 64% mean 57%

- E. 10 marks based on weightage for number of years since passing qualifying examination is up to 10 marks @ 1 mark per PG /Completion of PG / Super-specialty completed year.
- F. 5 marks of weightage will be provided to the candidates who have completed PG/Super Specialty from Central Institutions.
- G. 15 Marks to the contract service rendered in Government institutions
- H. Contract service can be calculated from the date of completion of Post-Graduation (Requisite qualification) only.
  - A. 2.5 marks per six months in Tribal Area.
  - B. 2 marks per six months in Rural Area.
  - C. 1 mark per six months in Urban Area
- I. Contract Service Certificate issued by the competent authority and signed by the Superintendent of Government Teaching Hospital /DM & HO / DCHS shall be submitted for claiming the contract weightage. Contract weightage will not be awarded, in case of non-submission of signed certificate from the above authorities.
- J. Contract weightage, if already utilized in any recruitment of state government, will not be awarded again. Candidates shall submit the declaration to that effect.. Non submission of declaration leads to non-entitlement of contract weightage
- K. Weightage will be awarded up to 15 Marks for the candidates who rendered their services on contract basis for COVID-19 duties.
  - a. Contract service will be reckoned up to the date of notification as per Government Memo no.4274/D1/2013, HM&FW(D1) Dept., dt.10.07.2014.
  - b. Spells of services will also be considered for weightage marks.
  - c. Contract weightage will be awarded as per G.O.Rt. No. 211, HM & FW (B2) Dept., Dated 08.05.2021and G.O.Rt.No.7 HM&FW(B2) Department Dt.06.01.2022 read with circular no.03/CHFW/2022, dated 11.02.2022 of CHFW

- d. Following documents to be submitted to claim COVID-19 weightage:
  - 1. Appointment order for COVID-19management.
  - 2. Monthly attendance certificates.
  - 3. Bank statement indicating payment of monthly remuneration along with COVID-19 weightage service certificate.
  - Service certificate from the competent authority in the prescribed proforma (DMHO/DCHS/Medical Superintendent in case of GGH).
  - Covid contract weightage will not be awarded in case of nonsubmission of any of the above certificates from d(1) to d(4).

#### 9. HOW TO APPLY :

- Applications shall be submitted online at dme.ap.nic.in from 15.02.2022 00.01 AM to 21.02.2022 11.59 PM
- The candidates shall have to pay the application fee Rs.1000/- for OC and Rs.500/for BC, SC, EWS, ST and PH candidates.
- **3.** Payment shall be done in Online Mode only.
- **4.** Candidates shall submit the application online and uploading following certificates in support of their claims in the application
  - a. Latest passport-size photo\*
  - b. SSC Certificates (proof of date of birth)\*
  - c. MBBS Degree Certificate\*
  - d. Internal Completion Certificate\*
  - e. PG Degree Certificate/Super-Specialty degree certificate\*
  - f. MBBS/PG degree/Super-Specialty degree marks memo\*
  - g. AP Medical Council Registration Certificate\*
  - h. Study Certificate from 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Class. In case of study of 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in Telangana and migrated to AP after bifurcation, then certificate from the revenue authorities to that effect as per G.O.Ms.No.132 & 133 GA (SPF&MC) Dept.13.06.2016 \* (proof of local candidate)
  - i. If a person belongs to Ex-serviceman category, certificate regarding the same has to be uploaded.
  - j. Candidates who claim for PH vacancy, must submit Disability Certificate to that extent, issued by concerned medical board or SADAREM.
  - k. Caste Certificate in case of SC/ST/BC or Social Status (for candidates claiming EWS) Certificate issued by Competent authority. If caste certificate is NOT submitted, then such candidate is considered as OC.
  - 1. Certificates in support of contract weightage
- 2. No application/certificate will be accepted in any mode other than ONLINE.
